

POSTER GUIDELINE

1. Posters must be printed on A1 (594 x 841 mm) size paper with vertical oriented (Portrait).
2. Character height recommendations: - Title: 2.4cm; Headings: 10 - 16mm; Text: 5 - 8mm
3. Include the title of the presentation, the name of the authors and the institution where the work was completed at the top of the poster.
4. After the title, the two most important panels are the introduction and the conclusion. On the basis of these two panels, a reader will decide whether to look at the results and perhaps talk to the presenter. These panels need to be very simple and concise and visually attractive.
5. The methods should be presented very simply and concisely.
6. Results should be presented graphically if possible. Avoid large tables of data.
7. Use the space to attract your audience for discussion, not to present complex details of methods and results.
8. IFS 2017 Committee/Authors will mount their posters in after registration (from 7th-8th November 2017) and remove them before dinner on the closing ceremony.

All posters left after the closing ceremony will be discarded.
